Format: 9 rounds FIDE-Swiss in the Cup and U2200 7 rounds FIDE-Swiss in U1800.

Time control: Cup & U2200: 40 moves in 90 min, followed by 30 min for the rest of the game, with an increment of 30 sec/move.
U1800: 90 min for the whole game plus 30 sec/move.

Registration: **Please register and pay the entry fee no later than December 16th to the Stockholm Chess Federation.** Registering and paying by December 1st earns you a 100 SEK discount. Payment options include bank transfer (IBAN: SE45 9500 0099 6042 0257 9589, BIC: NDEASESS), credit card, or PayPal on our website. Cash payments in SEK and late registrations can be made at the venue before 11 a.m. (10 a.m. for Rilton U1800) on the day of the start of the tournament for an additional 100 SEK fee. You register on our webpage: www.rilton.se/anmeldig.html. The first 300 registrants who have paid their starting fee are guaranteed participation.

Check-in All players must check-in in person or online by 11 a.m. on December 27 (Rilton U1800 January 2, 10 a.m.). Failure to do so can result in non-pairing. Check-in is available both on our website and at the venue.

Hotel: Book hotel rooms at www.rilton.se for more details. Prices per night, including breakfast, are as follows: Single cabin room: 770 SEK; Single room standard: 930 SEK; Double cabin room (one bed): 870 SEK; Double room standard: 1080 SEK; Triple room 1240 SEK and four beds room 1440 SEK. Availability is guaranteed until December 11th.

Rilton Cup

9 rounds. Eligibility: Players must have a minimum ELO rating of 2200 on the December 2024 rating list to participate. Exceptions include female players and juniors born in 2004 or later with a prior standard Elo rating of at least 2100 on any standard FIDE ELO list. The reigning champion of the last Rilton ELO tournament is also eligible. Qualification through Swedish national youth tournaments remain valid.

Entry fee: 1 300 SEK. FM/WFM: 900 SEK. Players born 2004 or later: 800 SEK. GM, WGM, IM and WIM play for free.

Women's prize: 6,000 SEK

Rating prizes: 3,000, 2,000 and 999 SEK per rating group. GMs and IMs cannot win rating prizes.

NB! Sofia rules are applied in Rilton Cup, no draw offers are allowed until after move 30.

Rilton U2200

9 rounds. Open for players with an ELO rating less than 2200.

Entry fee: 1 100 SEK, FM/WFM: 900 SEK, players born 2004 or later: 700 SEK.

Prizes (SEK): 1) 7,000, 2) 5,000, 3) 4,000, 4) 3,000, 5) 2,500, 6) 2,000, 7) 1,500, 8) 999, 9) 999, 10) 999.

Women's prize: 999 SEK

Rating prizes: 2,000, 1,500 and 999 SEK per rating group. Players without Elo rating cannot win rating prizes.

Rilton U1800

7 rounds 2/1 - 5/1. For players with an ELO rating less than 1800 on December 1st or January 1st.

Entry fee (SEK): 900 SEK. Players born 2005 or later: 700.

Prizes (SEK): 1) 4,000 2) 3,000 3) 2,000 4) 999 5) 999.

Rating prizes: 1 500, 900 and 700 SEK per rating group. Players without Elo rating cannot win rating prizes.

Prizes: Main and rating prizes are not shared and can both be won in all Rilton tournaments. The highest-rated players are ineligible for rating prizes. Preliminary tax will be deducted from all prizes as required by law. Electronic devices are prohibited in the playing area and must be surrendered to the organizers upon entry. The grace period is 30 minutes, and board pairings are made without any political considerations in the Rilton tournaments.

Fair Play: We work together with FIDE's Fair Play Commission and will follow FIDE's Fair Plays Rules and Commission's recommendations as much as possible.

Photos/videos: During the event, we will be capturing photographs and videos for various types of publications, including social media and our website. If you prefer not to be photographed or recorded, please inform us beforehand.
